Connected to Albert Hall by a stone, arched walkway. Offices include: Business, Education Department, Financial Aid, Registrar and Student Life.



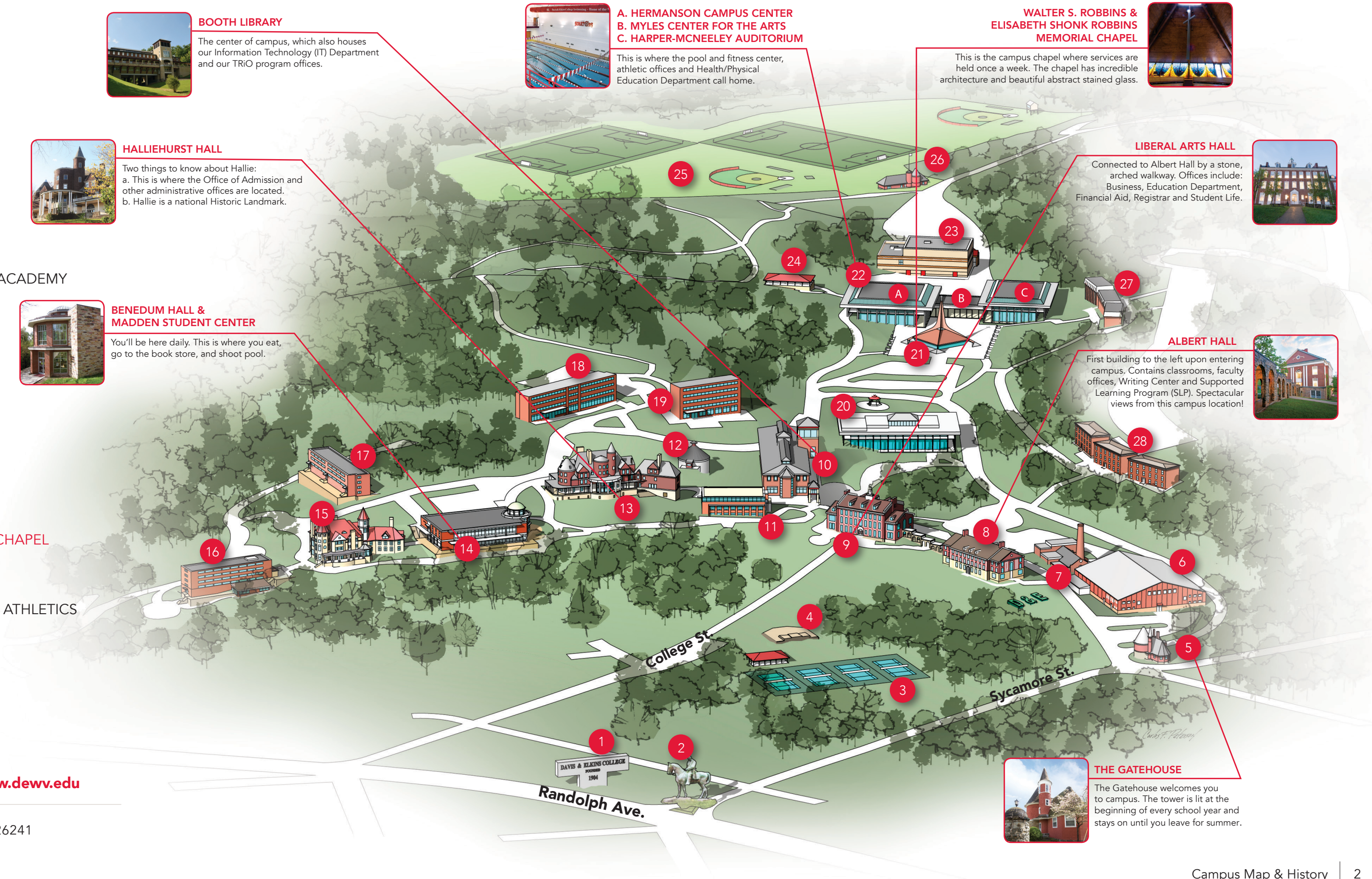
ALBERT HALL
