

Division Highlights

Business & Entrepreneurship Division

- All majors have 100% internship placement, many which turn into full time jobs after graduation and Accounting majors have a 100% job placement in their field within 3 months of graduation
- Recent graduates have started their own businesses in the fields of Marketing, Hospitality Management, Event Planning, and Accounting
- Finance and Economic majors go on to graduate schools around the world and most are now certified financial advisors, one of the most sought-after certification programs, while recent Accounting majors have either passed or are currently studying to sit for the CPA exam

Creative Arts Division

- Focus on creative, independent, thinking
- Classes open to all students, regardless of skill level
- Work to help students to prepare for their careers through student exhibitions and productions, and independent study and resume building opportunities

Education Division

- Accomplished: 100% passed performance licensure exam
- Hired: 100% employed in their field

Humanities Division

- Job placement in a variety of fields, including editing, media, law, writing, business, government, and teaching
- Three programs for students to choose from: Literature/Writing, History, and Philosophy/Religious Studies
- Co-curricular opportunities to present original research at conferences, work with the on-campus literary magazine, travel with the award-winning debate team, study abroad/away, and live and study at the Morrison-Novakovic Center for Faith and Public Policy

Natural Science Division

- Recent graduates of the Computer Science Department have entered graduate programs, or taken jobs with employers like IBM, US Department of Homeland Security, WV Division of Natural Resources and Kanawha County Schools
- Biology and Environmental Science: 90% acceptance rate to graduate or professional (medical, dental, veterinary, optometry) schools and successful job placement at WV DNR, US Fish & Wildlife Service, and National Parks.

- Chemistry: Students have participated in research projects in the chemistry department, in summer research programs at other institutions, and have presented at regional and national meetings such as those sponsored by the prestigious American Chemical Society

Nursing Division

- 100% NCLEX-RN pass rate
- 100% job placement rate
- Modern nursing simulation lab

Social Science Division

- 100% internship placement rate
- 100% of graduates from the 2017-2018 school year were either employed or in graduate school six months after graduation
- Students learn how to apply knowledge through hands-on activities, internships, field trips, community service, and close relationships with faculty mentors

Sport Science Division

- Exercise Science: 95% of students pursuing Physical Therapy are accepted (not only into graduate school, but a graduate school of their choice)
- Sport Management students will graduate with a coaching education emphasis with a strong business background
- The major in Community and Corporate Health prepares students to participate in a nearly \$8 billion industry that is growing at almost 8% a year while the programs in Physical Education and Health Education address the persistent shortage of teachers in these areas.
