We have now passed the 50% point of the semester. To date, we have had six students and two employees test positive for COVID-19 with all but one asymptomatic. The strict COVID protocols put in place are working thus far. However, an outbreak remains a possibility as soon as we become complacent and don't wear facial coverings, socially distance and wash hands. Also, large gatherings such as parties and off-campus travel put the entire campus at risk.

I am noticing increasing numbers of students not wearing facial coverings beyond your personal space. The wearing of masks is not voluntary. Compliance with the COVID-19 protocols, including facial coverings, is mandatory for all students, faculty, and staff, as well as any approved guests on campus. This is for the protection of us all, and to increase the likelihood that we can complete the entire semester remaining on campus.
