Davis & Elkins College received a total funding of \$490,161 from the Department of Education through the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund II (HEERF II) which is authorized by the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA). HEERF II emergency grant to students may be used for any portion of their cost of attendance, and/or for emergency expenses due to COVID-19 such as: tuition, housing, food, transportation, health care, mental health care, and child care.

The CRRSAA requires that institutions receiving funding under section 314(a)(1) (student portion) provide the "same amount" of funding in financial aid grants to students that it was listed on the CARES Act Section18004(a)(1) allocation table.

- Therefore, for this round, the total amount of HEERF II funds Davis & Elkins College received for distribution to students was \$490,161, the same as the one provided through the HEERF I.
- The estimated total number of students at Davis and Elkins College eligible to receive HEERF II Student Emergency Financial Aid Grants is 556.
- 3. The total amount of Emergency Relief Grants to be distributed to students that is required to be disclosed are as follows:

June 30, 2021 - \$490,161 to 432 students (Final Reporting for HEERF II)

The CRRSAA requires institutions to prioritize students with exceptional need, such as students who receive Pell Grants, in awarding financial aid grants to students.

- Based on that, Davis & Elkins College chose to award HEERF II funds in a need-based model, giving priority to students identified as having exceptional need, using these two methods:
  - 1. Pell Eligibility
  - 2. Application to Demonstrate Need
